### GO VIRGINIA REGION 9 COUNCIL SEEKING GRANT PROPOSALS FOR OPPORTUNITIES IN NEW PLAN UPDATE

**CHARLOTTESVILLE, VA** — The GO Virginia Region 9 Council is now accepting grant inquiries for the opportunities identified in the recently released Region 9 Growth & Diversification Plan Update (Plan Update).

Region 9, also known as the Piedmont Opportunity Corridor, has over \$1 million in grant funding available for regional projects. There are also over \$29 million in funds available for state-wide or multi-regional projects. Region 9 includes the Counties of Albemarle, Culpeper, Fauquier, Fluvanna, Greene, Louisa, Madison, Nelson, Orange, and Rappahannock, and the City of Charlottesville.

Project proposals must address specific opportunities listed in the recently released Plan Update and target growth in Food & Beverage Manufacturing, Light Manufacturing, Information Technology, Financial and Business Services or Biotechnology. Applications must also demonstrate regional collaboration among local government, business and higher education.

Since 2017, the Council has awarded eight projects a total of almost \$1.9 million leveraging over \$4.3 million in funding from project partners.
