## GO VIRGINIA REGION 9 COUNCIL SOLICITING PROJECT APPLICATIONS FOR APRIL 4 DEADLINE

Over \$1.5 Million in Funding Is Available for Initiatives That Advance Specific Opportunities Identified in Region 9's Growth & Diversification Plan

Charlottesville, Virginia – The GO Virginia Region 9 Council is soliciting applications for economic development projects that will advance specific opportunities identified in Region 9's Growth & Diversification Plan (Growth Plan). Applications received by the April 4 deadline have the potential to be reviewed and approved at the GO Virginia State Board meeting on June 14.

Projects proposals should strengthen and enhance the regional economy and contribute to the creation of higher-paying jobs as outlined in the Growth Plan. Proposals must demonstrate collaboration between business, education, and local government. Projects must focus on one or more of Region 9's target traded sectors and fall within one of four project frameworks:

Target Industries

Biomedical & Biotechnology

Financial & Business Services

Food & Beverage Manufacturing

Information Technology & Communications

Light Manufacturing

Project Frameworks
Talent Development
Innovation/Entrepreneurship
Growing Existing Businesses
Site Readiness

Over \$1.5 million in funding is available for projects in Region 9. Eligible applicants include public sector entities, nonprofits, public-private partnerships, and educational institutions, among others. Region 9, also referred to as the Piedmont Opportunity Corridor, encompasses the City of Charlottesville and the Counties of Albemarle, Culpeper, Fauquier, Fluvanna, Greene, Louisa, Madison, Nelson, Orange, and Rappahannock. Projects must engage at least two localities and require match dollars from non-state sources.

April 4 is also expected to be the last opportunity to apply for funding through the GO Virginia Economic Resilience and Recovery Program. Region 9 has over \$425k available to fund strategic initiatives designed to address the near- and long-term impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic.
