GO Virginia is a bipartisan, business-led economic development initiative designed to strengthen regional economies by targeting new investment in high-wage and export-oriented industries. The

Region 9 Council is responsible for awarding grants that promote economic diversification, workforce development, local talent pipelines, economic resiliency, and business-ready sites.

PROJECTS MUST:

- Lead to the creation of higher paying jobs
- Attract out-of-state revenue and/or generate exports across state lines
- Demonstrate collaboration between business, education, and government
- Include matching funds on a dollar-for-dollar basis from non-state resources
- Engage two or more localities
- Address priorities outlined in the Region 9 Growth & Diversification Plan
- Involve at least one project framework and focus on at least one target industry
