GO Virginia Region 9 Releases Request for Letters of Interest to Develop a Regional Entrepreneurship Plan

Plan expected to drive future entrepreneurship ecosystem investments

Charlottesville, Virginia – The Region 9 Council is soliciting Letters of Interest from organizations interested in developing a regional entrepreneurship plan. The Request for Letters of Interest is posted on the Region 9 Council website at <u>www.GOVirginia9.org/apply/</u>. The deadline is March 21, 2023.

The Region 9 Council will review Letters of Interest and if an organization is selected, they will be invited to complete a full grant proposal to be submitted to the GO Virginia Board. The grantee, with the oversight of the Region 9 Council, would use funds to develop a regional entrepreneurial ecosystem strategy report, including a three to five year action plan. The region's entrepreneurial ecosystem and entrepreneurship support organizations (ESOs) should be engaged in this process. The selected organization(s) would also coordinate with ESOs in the region and the Region 9 Council to develop future Region 9 grant proposals that will advance the newly identified strategies and opportunities.

The grant proposal may request no more than \$300,000 and activities must be completed within two years or less. A 2:1 match of non-state funds is required. The report development phase of the grant must be completed within the first 9-12 months of funding or earlier.
