




True or False: GO Virginia Region 9's population grew faster than the state over the past 2 decades.




Population Percent Change by Decade

GO Virginia Region 9 Components of Population Change, 2010-2021




Regional growth is driven by domestic migration, some natural growth pre-COVID-19




